About the Lemgo Local Amateur Radio Club DOK: N26 ...

Our local club has got a long and changing past. It was first mentioned in 1948, but 6 years later it closed down for want of members. On November 20, 1964 a new club was founded for Lippe's OMs in the centrally located city of Lage. Its code was DOK N26. More and more members joined the club and finally the club split and some members joined the local club in Bad Salzuflen. From March 22, 1970 the seat of the original club became Lemgo and the former chairman Ernst Fasse (DK2AC) remained chairman of the now called Lemgo Local Amateur Radio Club DOK N26.

Since 2001 Wolfgang Riechert (DL2YCK) has been our successful chairman, and in December 2007 he was reconfirmed for another 2 years, supported by our man for public relations Hans-Georg Matthies (DC1OW).

On June 1, 2007 the Lemgo Local Amateur Radio Club N26 had its own website on the Net.

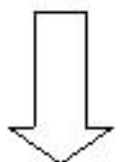
On September 13, 2007 the club moved from its rooms in the Wallschule Lemgo to the new clubrooms in Lemgo-Entrup. On December 21, 2007 the extensive renovation of the new rooms was celebrated during a housewarming Christmas party.

In 2008 for interested participants requiring an amateur radio operators license class E a training was offered. Over the following years talks were given by guest speakers about HamNet, emergency communication and Laser communication.

Since 2010 youth work has been one of our main activities. Together with organizations like AWO - Lemgo and Ferienfreizeit der Gemeinde Extertal we gave young people some information about amateur radio and we realized various practical projects like building a small receiver. The responsibility for these activities has been in the good hands of Herbert (DF5QC), Dieter (DF8EE), Udo (DL5RR) and Wolfgang (DL2YCK).

Gerhard Fasse (DJ1FQ) supports our club as a member of the board for digital media and operating modes. In early 2010 our club initiated an exchange of ideas and a cooperation with the local ham clubs of Bad Salzuflen (N30), Detmold (N04) and Lage (N45). The first result was a common Field Day in July 2011.

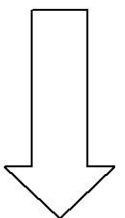
